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WHAT IS GOD REALLY DOING TODAY?

There is no more important question in all the world than “What is God doing today?” There are innumerable voices within professing Christianity and the world at large, who claim to know the answer to this question. But what we want to know is “What God is REALLY doing today?”

Why doesn’t anyone know the answer to this question? Many say that even if there is a God, it is impossible to know what He is doing. He is a capricious and unpredictable God, and you can never guess what He will do next. Maybe He will do something. Maybe He won’t. Who knows? Your guess is as good as mine. There is no

rhyme or reason to His madness.

Others say what God is doing is determined by reading the circumstances of our lives, like tea leaves at the bottom of a cup. If things are going well, God must be pleased with us. If things are going poorly, well, He may be angry with us, or maybe He is trying to teach us something, or maybe He is trying to build our character. You just need to figure out how to get back into His good graces.

Still others think we can know God’s will by randomly claiming the promises of the Bible. Just name it and claim it, and it is ours! But if these human ideas show anything, they show our complete ignorance of God and His will. So, I

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What We Believe, And Why We Believe It!

Recently, Pastor Peter began a new series entitled: “What We Believe and Why We Believe it.” Knowing what we believe is a good start but it is not enough. Out in the world, even the so called “Christian” world, there are all kinds of competing ideas and knowing what is right can only take us so far. If you don’t know WHY you believe what you be-

lieve, then you will be blown about by every wind of doctrine, which will destabilize your Christian life, and prevent you from helping others be stabilized. Saying you believe something because that is what your pastor says, or what your favorite author says or what your esteemed Bible teacher says can only be

ask the question again:

WHAT IS GOD REALLY DOING TODAY?

Contrary to all these erroneous speculations about God and His will, the Apostle Paul tells us that not only *can* we know what God is doing today, but that it is inexcusable if we don't know what He is doing today! For most of Christians the Mystery (or Secret) of God's will is still a mystery. But God says He has now made it known.

Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my (Paul's) Gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the Revelation of the Mystery, kept secret since the world began...(Rom. 16:25)

In Time Past God kept what He would be doing today a 'mystery,' a "secret." Ephesians describes it as something not known in other ages (Eph. 3:5), consisting of the *unsearchable* riches of Christ (3:8), which *had been hid away since the beginning of creation*, NOT in the Old Testament or the parables of Jesus or the ministry of Peter and the Twelve, but IN GOD (3:9)!

BUT NOW (the Mystery that had been kept secret) is made manifest, and by the prophetic Scriptures (of Paul) made known to all nations, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, for the obedience of the faith—to God, alone wise, be glory through Jesus Christ forever. Amen.
(Rom. 16:26 NKJV)

BUT NOW!! Thank God for that phrase! BUT NOW God has revealed, manifested, made known what before had been kept secret, and He revealed it to and through the Apostle Paul, who recorded it permanently for us in his Epistles. The Mystery of God's plan for today is no longer a mystery! God has made it known for all to see (Rom. 16:25-26; Eph. 3; 16:15-26)!

Therefore, not only is what God is doing today knowable, but it is inexcusable if we don't know it! So then, why is the Mystery still a mystery to the vast majority of professing "Christianity" in general and even believing Christianity in specific when God says clearly that He has made it known?

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable and perfect will of God (Rom. 12:2).

How can God expect us to demonstrate His good and perfect will if it is impossible for us to know what it is! The key to answering this is found in Paul's beginning phrase: **I beseech you by the MERCIES OF GOD.** What are the mercies of God? We don't need to guess. Paul tells us in the verses just before these:

For I would not, brethren that ye should be ignorant of this Mystery ... For as ye (Gentiles) in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained MERCY through their (Israel's) unbelief; even so have these also now not believed, that through your MERCY they also may obtain MERCY. For God has concluded all in unbelief, that He might have MERCY upon all (Rom. 11:25-32).

This is the "mercies of God." God is doing something new today that is distinct from what He had done in the past, and we are supposed to renew our minds with it. In the Old Testament, the Gospel accounts of Christ's earthly ministry, and the ministry

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of Peter and the 12, God was showing mercy toward the Gentiles with Israel and through her RISE because of her belief or faith. BUT NOW, through Paul, God announces the fact that this is NOT what He is doing today. Today He is showing mercy to the Gentiles apart from Israel and through her FALL because of her unbelief.

This is what God is really doing today!

TODAY, GOD IS MANIFESTING THE BUT NOW RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD

BUT NOW, the Righteousness of God is being manifested, apart from the Law and witnessed to by the Law and the Prophets ... for all have sinned and come short of the glory of God (Rom. 3:21-23).

This BUT NOW Righteousness of God declares His Righteousness in justifying ungodly sinners on enemy status before Him. If we were to boil down what God is doing today to its most fundamental essence, it is this: Today God is displaying His Righteousness in saving His enemies because He has no friends. But isn't this what He has always done? Absolutely not.

According to what God revealed in the Old Testament, the Gospels, and the ministry of Peter and the 12 in early Acts, God had been displaying the Righteousness of God in delivering His friends (believing Israel and her friends) and DESTROYING His enemies in accord with His promises to Abraham: **I will bless them that bless you** (the friends of Abraham and through him believing Israel and her Gentile friends) **and curse them that curse you** (unbelieving Israel and Gentile enemies) (Gen. 12:3). In short, God promised Abraham, and through him the Nation of Israel, that He would bless their (and His) friends

and destroy their (and His) enemies. In Israel's Prophetic Program as recorded in the Old Testament, the Gospels, and the ministry of the 12, God was displaying His Righteousness in delivering His friends and destroying His enemies.

God did this with Moses in the Exodus. He delivered Israel and destroyed Egypt. He did this with Joshua when He brought Israel into the Promised Land while destroying her enemies out of the Land.

Abraham was a Friend of God (Is. 41:8), and David was a man after God's Own heart (1 Sam. 13:14). This is what they prayed for: That God would operate in accord with the display of His Righteousness in delivering them while destroying their enemies.

Deliver me in thy righteousness, and cause me to escape ... and save me ... Deliver me, O my God, out of the hand of the wicked ... unrighteous ... and cruel man ... mine enemies speak against me and they that lay in wait for my soul ... O my God, make haste for my help. Let them (*his enemies*) be confounded and consumed ... (Ps. 71)

God's friends the prophets spoke about this display of God's Righteousness as well:

But with righteousness shall He judge the poor and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth (*His friends*): And He will smite the earth (*His enemies*) with the rod of His mouth ... (Is 11:4).

O mine enemy ... until He plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: He will bring me forth to the light ... I shall behold His righteousness ... mine enemy shall see it ... shame shall cover her ... she shall be trodden down as mire ... (Micah 7:8-10).

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The final words of the Old Testament look forward to the full display of this Righteousness in the future.

For behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; And all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly (*His enemies*), shall be stubble.

And the day that cometh shall burn them (*His enemies*) up, saith the Lord of Hosts ... But unto you that fear My Name (*His friends*) shall the Sun of Righteousness arise with healing in His wings...(Mal. 4:1-2)

And the New Testament opens by looking for this same display of God's Righteousness in saving His friends and destroying His enemies. Zacharias, filled with the Spirit, prophesied, saying:

That He would grant unto us that we (*His friends*) being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve Him without fear in holiness and righteousness before Him. (Lk. 1:68-75)

And even after the death and resurrection of Christ, Peter and the 12 were still looking for the full display of this Righteousness:

A prophet (*Jesus Christ*) shall the Lord your God raise up unto you ... Him shall ye hear (*His friends*) ... every soul who will not hear (*His enemies*) that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people ... (Acts 3:22-23).

Everything revealed prior to the raising up of the Apostle Paul had to do with the display of the Righteousness of God whereby God saves His friends and destroys His enemies.

While this may be good news for times when believing Israel is operating in accord with her promises and covenants, thereby making Jews and Gentiles who associate with her God's friends, what happens during a time when God has cast aside national Israel in unbelief because of her rejection of Christ?

GETTING SAVED IS NOT OUR WAY TO GET GOD INVOLVED IN OUR THINGS!

What happens during a time when God gathers ALL together—Jews and Gentiles—in unbelief, under sin, on enemy status before Him (Rom. 3:9-20; 5:6-10; 11)? In the revelation of His Righteousness made known in the Old Testament, the Gospels, and early Acts, God extends mercy to the world through believing Israel and her RISE. But what happens when Israel becomes unbelieving and falls? Prior to Paul, God had never revealed a way whereby He would extend mercy to the Gentiles through Israel's *unbelief*. Before Paul, He had never revealed a way whereby He could bless the world, *apart* from Israel and through her FALL.

If God made no further revelation of His Righteousness, the whole world, Jew and Gentile alike, would be completely and utterly hopeless. The world was rushing into just such a state when Israel once-and-for-all rebelled against God in rejecting Christ at the stoning of Stephen. Not only had the Gentiles rejected and killed their Creator, Israel had joined arms with them in rejecting and killing her Messiah and King at the Cross! In their joint rejection of Christ, the whole world stood in abject rebellion against God, worthy only of His Wrath and Judgment.

If God made no new revelation of His Righteousness, the only thing He could do is what Peter expected Him to do in early Acts: Return in His Wrath and Judgment to Destroy His Enemies (Acts 2-3)! The display of the Righteous-

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ness of God in saving His friends and destroying His enemies offers no hope to today's world. Once the nation Israel joined hands with the Gentile nations, all the people of the world entered into enemy status before God. That includes me. And that includes you.

But Christ didn't return in His wrath and judgment. Instead of returning to fulfill the Revelation of Righteousness in saving His friends and destroying His enemies, He returned to make known a new revelation of His Righteousness, the BUT NOW Righteousness of God (Rom. 3:21) whereby He saves His ENEMIES because He has no friends! He provided the perfect remedy for a time when the whole world stands on enemy status before God. A time during which He dispenses the riches of His Love, Grace and Mercy: The Dispensation of Grace.

Why did God do this through Paul? Why didn't He just use Peter or one of the other 12 apostles? Why did it have to be Paul? That is the million dollar question of true Christianity. Remember, before Paul was Paul, he was Saul, the leader of the persecution against Christ and His followers, making him God's worst enemy and chief sinner (Acts 22:4-5, 19; 1 Tim. 1:12-17). While the 12 were ungodly sinners like Paul, unlike Paul, they were on friendship status with God when Christ confronted them. Paul, however, was on enemy status before God. If the Risen Christ returned to display the Righteousness of God in saving His friends and destroying His enemies, He should have struck Paul down with His Wrath and Judgment unto destruction. Instead He returned and struck Paul down with His grace and peace unto salvation (Acts 9:4ff).

Only a new revelation of God's Righteousness could save His worst enemy and chief sinner, making Paul the prototype for what He is doing today. Today He is displaying the BUT NOW Righteousness of God whereby He is declaring His Righteousness in justifying ungodly sinners on enemy status before Him. He is declaring His Righteousness in saving His enemies.

So, let's be as clear as possible: Today, in the most fundamental terms, God is displaying the Righteousness of God in saving His enemies because He has no friends. Today, God, in the riches of His longsuffering forbearing goodness is holding back His wrath and judgment against sin and sinners not because He doesn't care about sin but because He desires to save as many sinful enemies as possible before He returns in His Wrath and Judgment to destroy them.

Once this fundamental truth is grasped, believing Christianity, true Christianity, leaves behind the fantasy world of man-made religions and theological systems and enters into the reality of God's Truth that tells us exactly what He is doing today.

This answers the age old question of philosophers: If there is a loving God why does He allow evil, sin and sinners to continue in the world? Most answer this by concluding there is no God, at least no loving God. But if

God is now displaying His BUT NOW Righteousness in saving His enemies before He returns to destroy them, then this doesn't call into question His Deity and Love, it proves and displays them!

This is what God is doing today!

WHAT IS GOD REALLY DOING TODAY?

TODAY, GOD IS JUSTIFYING UN-GODLY SINNERS ON ENEMY STATUS BEFORE HIM


The revelation of the BUT NOW Righteousness of God is recorded for us in the Letters of Paul, and most systematically in Romans and Ephesians. There we learn that God brings us to Himself by justifying sinners on the basis of grace and faith in Christ and His redemptive work on the Cross FOR US. There, He dealt perfectly and completely with the sin/sins/ sinner problem once and for all in a way that fully satisfied all the demands of an infinitely Holy, Righteous and Just God. In justifying ungodly sinners, who are on enemy status before Him, God declares His Righteousness (Rom. 3:21-26), displays His Glory (4:5, 22), and commends His Love (5:8-10).

This answers the age old question of Job: How shall a man (sinner) be just before God (Job 25:4)? Answer: A sinner is justified before God by grace through faith on the basis of the redemptive work of Christ on the Cross (Rom. 3:21-26)!

This is what God is doing today!

TODAY, GOD IS MAKING US PARTICIPANTS IN HIS GIFT/FAITH RIGHTEOUSNESS

Paul gives a step-by-step guide that explains what God is doing today with those He has justified. In saving sinners from the pit of sin and death, He left the heavenly realm and came down into the muck and mire of fallen humanity for the sole purpose of going to the Cross where He died for us (Gal. 2:20). Then He was raised from the dead in the Glory of the Father, and—miracle of miracles—we were raised with



Him and seated together with Him in the heavens:

But God who is rich in mercy, for His great love wherewith He loved us, even when we were dead in sins, has quickened us together with Christ (by grace ye are saved) and has raised us up together with Christ, and made us to sit together with Christ in heavenly places in Christ Jesus (Eph. 2:4-6).

What more could you ask for?

1. **HE FORGIVES OUR SINS.** (Rom. 4:8). **Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered (Rom. 4:7).**

But there is more, much more!

2. **HE IMPUTES OUR FAITH FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS.**

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He not only forgave our sins negatively, He also credits our faith for righteousness, positively. **But to him who worketh not but believes on Him that justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness** (Rom. 4:5).

He brings the believing sinner, who had been on enemy status before Him, into righteousness status before Him. But there is even more, much more!

3. HE IMPARTS HIS LIFE TO US.

Even so, by the righteousness of One (Christ) the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life, eternal life (Rom. 5:18; 6:23). But there is more, much more!

4. HE MAKES US PARTICIPANTS OF HIS GLORY

And whom He justified, them He also glorified (Rom. 8:30). But there's more, much more.

5. HE SEATS US IN THE HEAVENLIES WITH CHRIST

And it is there, in the heavens, that we will display God's glory forevermore according to Eph 2:4-7.

All of this is what God is doing today!

CONNECTING THE DOTS

Now that we know exactly what God is doing today, let it change our thinking and revolutionize our Christian lives. If you are expecting God to do anything that is not based on this, then let God's Word correct your thinking and adjust your expectations. If your prayer life is not thankful communion with the Father about this, then let the Holy Spirit align your prayers with God's Truth. If your worship is not guided by this, then let God's Word guide you into true worship. Anything you do that is not aligned with this is not of God. All the prayer in the world won't coerce God into doing something He has said He is not doing today.

To continue in willful ignorance only results in a disappointed, defeated and despairing Christian life. To replace the truth about what God is really doing today with our own imaginations isn't "faith," it's just wishful thinking, and always results in a walk that is not pleasing to God. True maturity and spirituality come when believers understand what God is doing today from the teachings of Paul and allow that to work in and through them to advance God's things not their own things.

What We Believe, And Why We Believe It!

stretched so far because all that really matters is what God says! The only thing that is always 100% true and never changes is what God says. The only thing that can bring stability to our Christian lives is what God says. The only thing that can build-up and establish others is what God says.

The first topic in the series is CREATION.

THE QUESTIONS

In his Sunday School class Peter asked the students, “Who made the world?” They all answered, “God did!” Then he asked, “How do you know?” They answered, “Because the Bible says so!” Then he asked, “Where?” And this question took them on a journey through the Bible that not only told them what to believe but why they should believe it.

GOD CREATED THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH (Gen. 1:1)

Genesis 1 is the anchor passage for CREATION. It, along with other supporting passages, enables us to show from Scripture God’s truth about CREATION. First of all, this verse explains WHO created all things—God created all things! **In the beginning GOD**—this is a dogmatic statement that assumes the prior reality of the uncreated, always existing God as the One Who created all things.

How did God create all things? And God SAID: **Let there be light: And there was light!** ... And God SAID: **Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: And it was so!** ... And God SAID: **Let the earth bring forth grass and herb yielding seed ... And it was so!** ... And God SAID **let there be lights in the firmament of heaven ... And it was so** (Gen. 1)!

God SAID it, that is how He created all

things. By the power of his word what He said instantly happened. All God needed to do was say it, and it powerfully came into being. It was all by the power of His Word.

GOD CREATED ALL THINGS THROUGH THE WORD, GOD THE SON, THE LORD JESUS CHRIST. (John 1:1)

John 1:1-3 is a commentary on Genesis 1, explaining that: **In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. And all things were made by Him.** When God spoke creation into existence through His word in Genesis 1, John explains that it was the Word who did it. But who is the Word? **And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth** (Jn. 1:14). The Word, who was (and is) God Himself, was made flesh in the Person of the Lord Jesus Christ. God’s creative word that spoke the universe into existence was carried out by God’s Word, God the Son, Jesus Christ.

THE WHOLE CREATION WAS CREATED BY CHRIST AND IS FOR HIM AND IS SUSTAINED BY HIM. (Col. 1:16-17)

Speaking of the Lord Jesus Christ, Paul says: **For by Him were all things created ... by Him and for Him: And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist.** (Col. 1:16-17). The reason the universe is in its present stable state and not exploding away in complete chaos is because the Word of God who created it, the Lord Jesus Christ, is holding it together by His sustaining power.

THIS TRUTH IS RECEIVED BY FAITH (Heb. 11:3)

What We Believe, And Why We Believe It!

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear (Heb. 11:3).

We live in a world that denies God's creation of the universe. In fact, they deny His very existence. As Christians, we are accused of having faith in the Bible's creation truths, and, yes, we do accept it by faith. At some point there needs to be a belief, a confidence that what God has said is reliable and eternally true.

Yes, it is by faith. Faith is not jumping in some dark hole hoping you land at the bottom. Faith has a substance, a content that is focused on the Person and work of God through Christ. We grasp and comprehend BY FAITH that the worlds were framed by the Word of God. God said it, and it was so. We grasp and comprehend BY FAITH that in the beginning the Word was with God, and the Word was God. We grasp and comprehend BY FAITH that the things which are seen were not made from other things but from nothing.

Whenever humans make things, they always have something to start with. A builder starts with dirt and wood and stones and metal, and then puts them together in a way that results in a house. Without these things there would be no house. This is the way people make things, but this is not the way God creates things. When God created the universe, He created it out of nothing by the power of His Word. In Him is life, and life comes from God.

The world denies this, and as believers we need to know and understand from the Word of God that it was God who created the heaven and the earth by the living Word, God the Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, who created all things and by Whom all things consist.

We know and receive this BY FAITH.

FAITH:
WHAT GOD SAYS IS ETERNALLY TRUE
(Heb. 11:1)

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. (Heb. 11:1)

What is faith? Faith is the substance (the reality, the foundation) of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Biblical faith is the capacity to believe that what God has said is eternally true. In fallible human courts of law, evidence is brought in and presented for all to see and hear. But this not so with God. God is infallible. Therefore, all we need to know is that what He has said provides with all the evidence of things not seen that we need. It is of faith.

God has said of His creation that the things that appear were not made from things that existed before but were made out of nothing. The theological term for the is *ex nihilo*—Creation out of nothing. Out of the power of His infinite wisdom and eternal Word, He powerfully brought the universe into existence

CREATION HAS FALLEN BECAUSE OF SIN AND UNBELIEF (Rom. 1:18-22)

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God has showed it unto them. For the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him not as God, neither were

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thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools...(Rom. 1:18-22)

This passage explains how the universe got into the mess that it is in today. In rejecting God and His truth in unbelief, mankind was left with its own crazy godless ideas. God's truth about His invisible Being—His invisible Power and Deity—is clearly seen and understood by the people He made. He revealed Himself to them, yet they still rejected Him, therefore, they are without excuse! God has provided infinite evidence that He is the omnipotent, all-powerful God, and mankind knew it and understood it but rejected it anyway, refusing to glorify Him, the One who created the universe and the people in it.

In rejecting God's Glory mankind became *unglorious*, shameful, and worshipped and served the idols of corruptible creation rather than the uncorruptible God who created it (Rom. 1:23-25). In rejecting God's Truth, they accepted the Lie. They became vain in their imaginations and their foolish heart was darkened. The foolish ideas that the world teach arise out of this darkness of unbelief whether it be the origin of the universe out of some godless Big Bang, or the origin of humanity out of godless evolution. It is all just darkness, foolishness, that leads to sin and death

(Rom. 1:32).

Humanity didn't evolve, it devolved:

They changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible men and to birds and to four-footed beasts and to creeping things (Rom. 1:23).

The world is now in rebellion against God

because mankind has denied the Power and Deity of God, and it is in that void that the God rejecting philosophies of the world take root and grow. Unbelieving humanity needs to come up with alternate explanations for the presence of this

universe and man, no matter how ridiculous. God says it is all vanity and foolishness. **Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools—morons.** Such is the state of fallen humanity.

We need to know this when we go out into the world—to school, to work, to play. The world denies God and His Word and is in rebellion against Him. We better not just know what we believe but why we believe it if we are going to stand firm against the lies of the world and help others stand firm as well.!








